Detailed itinerary for Amazing South Africa:

Day	Location	Activities
1	Johannesburg	Your guide will be waiting for you at arrival in Johannesburg airport and will transfer you to your accommodation for the night.
2	Kruger National Park 461 km	<p>We leave Johannesburg behind us and head to the world-renowned Kruger National Park. On the way we visit some of the breathtaking sights on the magnificent Panorama Route.</p> <p>We will visit scenic landmarks such as Bourke's Luck Potholes, the Three Rondavels and God's Window, where you can walk in the thick, indigenous mist forest that stands amongst the clouds some 800m above Blyde River Canyon.</p>
3	Kruger National Park	<p>The next few days will be spent searching for the big 5 in the Kruger National Park. You will be enjoying several game drives a day.</p> <p>A morning bush walk with a Kruger ranger is also included on one of those days.</p>
4	Kruger National Park	We continue our stay in the Kruger National Park.
5	Swaziland 171 km	<p>After a last morning game drive we leave the Kruger National Park behind us and cross the border into Swaziland. We will be staying in the Mlilwane Wildlife Sanctuary which is Swaziland's oldest reserve.</p> <p>In the evening we will have some traditional Swazi dancing (available most nights).</p> <p>You will enjoy a game drive here and have the opportunity to do a self-guided hike.</p>
6	Swaziland	<p>We continue our stay in Swaziland.</p> <p>Optional activities include: Umphakatsi cultural experience, Roan game drive, Guided birding walk, Esitjeni village walk, Sunrise/sunset game drive, Horse riding, Mountain biking</p>
7	St. Lucia – Isimangaliso Wetland park 268 km	<p>We Leave Swaziland and make our way to the Isimangaliso Wetland Park. This area includes lakes, beaches, coral reefs, wetlands, woodlands, coastal forests and grasslands and houses an incredible diversity of animal, bird and marine life.</p> <p>You will enjoy a sunset cruise on the lagoon. See hippo and crocodiles in their natural habitat from the comfort of a custom-built passenger ferry.</p>
8	Hluhluwe – Imfolozi Game Reserve 84 km	<p>Today we will enjoy a game drive in the Hluhluwe-Imfolozi Game Reserve.</p> <p>Set in the heart of Zululand, Hluhluwe-Imfolozi is the oldest game reserve in Africa where today the "big five" of African</p>

		legend stalk the verdant savannah. Established in 1895, game viewing is the prime attraction. Viewing hides overlook waterholes enabling visitors to see animals at close range.
9	Durban 228 km	We will spend today enjoying the vibrant city of Durban, a natural paradise known for its gorgeous coastline of sun-kissed beaches and subtropical climate. You can spend the rest of the day enjoying the city and its beaches on your own or you can pay a visit to uShaka Marine World.
10	Drakensberg Mountains - Royal Natal National Park 279 km	We leave Durban behind us and head to the famous Drakensberg Mountains. We will pay a visit to the Royal Natal or Ukhahlamba Drakensberg National Park. The Drakensberg is the highest mountain range in South Africa, measuring over 3000 metres.
11	Drakensberg Mountains - Royal Natal National Park	Today you can continue to enjoy your beautiful surroundings and spend the day relaxing or taking part in one of the many available activities. Optional activities include: Guided hikes, Fly fishing, Self guided walks, Guided horse rides, Mountain biking, Paint ball, Zip line, Quad biking and more...
12	Lesotho 323 km	Today we make our way across the Lesotho border. Lesotho, known as the Mountain Kingdom or Kingdom in the Sky, holds a wealth of different experiences in store. Mountains, valleys and rivers present unforgettable panoramas.
13	Lesotho	Enjoy all what Lesotho has to offer. Optional activities include: Visit to local village/school/museum, hiking, pony trekking, mountain biking, Sangoma visit
14	Cintsa 552 km	Next stop on our adventure is the coastal town of Cintsa. Cintsa offers a haven in a tranquil setting, surrounded by lush indigenous forest and thicket, and an amazing bird life. The lagoon predominates, and sand dunes and a wonderfully long stretch of beach, entice one to stay.
15	Cintsa	Whether you simply want to relax and enjoy a day by the beach or you wish to partake in some more adventurous activities, Cintsa has this and much more to offer. Optional activities include: quadbiking, horse riding, surfing, golf, abseiling, zip lining and more ...
16	Addo Elephant National Park 319 km	We leave early and head to the magnificent Addo Elephant National Park which houses the big 7 (the big 5 + Whale and Great White Shark). We will spend the day enjoying a number of game drives.
17	Tsitsikamma National Park 257 km	After a last morning game drive we drive on towards the Tsitsikamma National Park. Optional activities include: zip lining, canopy tour, kayaking, bungee jumping, hiking ... Along the South Coast of South Africa lies one of the most beautiful stretches of coastline in the world, home to the

		Garden Route National Park. Tsitsikamma is a Khoisan word meaning "place of much water". The Park incorporates 80 km of rocky coastline with spectacular sea and landscapes, a remote mountainous region with secluded valleys covered in mountain Fynbos and temperate high forests with deep river gorges leading down to the sea.
18	Knysna 95 km	<p>We travel to the beautiful seaside town of Knysna where we stop at the Knysna Elephant Centre for a chance to touch and feed the elephants.</p> <p>The rest of the day is spent exploring this unique town or you may opt to visit Knysna's Monkeyland or Birds of Eden.</p>
19	Oudtshoorn 119 km	<p>We continue on the garden route and travel more inland towards Oudtshoorn where we pay a visit to an ostrich farm where you will be able to meet and ride ostriches.</p> <p>You will also have the option to visit the Cango Caves or the Cango Ranch.</p>
20	Hermanus 361 km	<p>We make a stop at the Southernmost tip of Africa before we head to Hermanus, known as the best land based whale watching destination in the world.</p> <p>From June to December you will be able to enjoy looking for these magnificent creatures in Hermanus' Walker Bay. You will also have the option to go on a whale boat cruise. Out of whale season Hermanus has much more to offer such as wine tasting, gorgeous scenery and cliff paths, pristine beaches, sea kayaking and much more...</p>
21	Cape Town 122 km	<p>Our last stop on the trip is South Africa's Mother City, Cape Town.</p> <p>After our arrival in Cape Town we will take you on a tour of the Cape Peninsula. You will have the opportunity to see the Cape Point Nature Reserve, the Cape of Good Hope, Simons Town and its penguin colony, False Bay, Camps Bay and more.</p>
22	Cape Town	Today you are transported to the airport for your flight home.
