Detailed itinerary for Ultimate Namibia:

Day	Location	Activities
1	Windhoek	<p>Your guide will be waiting for you at arrival at Windhoek airport and will transfer you to your accommodation for the night.</p> <p>You can spend the day relaxing at the lodge or your guide can take you on a small city tour.</p>
2	Quivertree Forest 494 km	<p>Leaving Windhoek we go south towards the Quivertree Forest (Kokerboom Woud in Afrikaans). The forest consists of a species of aloe which is locally known as "quiver tree" because bushmen use its branches to make quivers. You will enjoy a visit to the Giant's Playground (mighty dolomite rock formations) and a beautiful sunset in the forest.</p>
3	Fish River Canyon 184 km	<p>A 3 hour drive takes us to the Fish River Canyon. Enjoy a scenic walk along the edge of the largest canyon in Africa and experience the amazing sunset.</p> <p>Located in the /Ai-/Ais Richtersveld Transfrontier Park, the Fish River Canyon is one of the largest canyons in the world. Around 160 km in length and reaching a depth in excess of 500 meters, it is one of the main tourist attractions in the south of the country.</p>
4	Klein-Aus 298 km	<p>On our way to the desert, we stop for the night at Klein-Aus.</p> <p>Klein-Aus is nestled in the rocky Aus Mountains and is famed for its extensive and lovely vistas. Contributing to the scenery are the wild horses of the Namib Desert.</p>
5	Namib-Naukluft National Park 407 km	<p>This morning we leave Klein-Aus behind and head for the desert.</p> <p>The Namib-Naukluft National Park encompasses part of the Namib Desert and the Naukluft mountain range. It is the largest game park in Africa and the fourth largest in the world. The most well-known area of the park is Sossusvlei, which is the main visitor attraction in Namibia.</p>
6	Namib-Naukluft National Park	<p>We get up very early today to climb the famous Dune 45 and experience the unique view and sunrise over the desert dunes. After breakfast we head further into the park to see Sossusvlei and Deadvlei as well as Sesriem Canyon.</p>
7	Swakopmund 293 km	<p>This morning we head to Swakopmund. On the way we pay a visit to Solitaire.</p> <p>Solitaire is a small settlement in the Khomas Region of central Namibia near the Namib-Naukluft National Park.</p> <p>The charming coastal town of Swakopmund offers the possibility of many adventurous activities.</p>
8	Swakopmund	<p>Today is reserved for any activities you wish to enjoy in the area. Or you can explore the beautiful town and its beach.</p>
9	Spitzkoppe	<p>We start off today by driving a small part up the skeleton coast up to Henties Bay.</p>

	182 km	<p>Next, we head inland to the Spitzkoppe.</p> <p>The Spitzkoppe is a group of bald granite peaks or inselbergs located between Usakos and Swakopmund in the Namib desert of Namibia. The granite is more than 120 million years old and the highest outcrop rises about 1,784 metres above sea level.</p>
10	Grootberg 344 km	<p>This morning we first pay a visit to Brandberg Mountain where you have the option to take a 3h hike to see the rock art.</p> <p>Later that day we drive to Grootberg. Possible optional activities include rhino tracking, guided walks, game/scenic drive, Damaraland wildlife excursion.</p>
11	Grootberg	Today you can enjoy some of the many optional activities.
12	Etosha National Park 259 km	<p>We pay a visit to a local Himba village on our way to Etosha.</p> <p>The next few days will be spent enjoying the many beautiful sights and animals of the Etosha National Park.</p> <p>You will enjoy many game drives and can spend the rest of the day relaxing by the pool.</p>
13	Etosha National Park	We continue our visit to Etosha with more game drives.
14	Rundu 514 km	Today will be a long drive towards Rundu which is the first town of the Caprivi Strip, the tropical Northern border of Namibia.
15	Rundu	<p>You can take part in some of the available optional activities or take your time to explore the area on your own.</p> <p>In the evening you can enjoy a sundowner cruise on the Okavango River.</p>
16	Divundu 203 km	<p>We continue along the Caprivi strip towards Ngepi.</p> <p>Some of the many optional activities here include the Namibian delta experience, sunset & sunrise boat cruises, fishing, mokoro trips, Dragon River rafting, guided nature and village walks, game drives or just relax in the world famous "Croc" Pool.</p> <p>We will also pay a visit to the Popa falls, a series of rapids, waterways and islands on the Okavango River. There is a walkway into the middle of the river, after this you are free to scramble over the rocks in the river.</p>
17	Divundu	Today you can continue to enjoy the many optional activities or just relax at the camp.
18	Waterberg 627 km	A long day of driving will bring us to the Waterberg Plateau National Park.
19	Waterberg	Today you can enjoy a Rhino drive and one of the many other optional activities such as a plateau hike, nature trails, history path or a cultural tour.
20	Windhoek 305 km	A half day drive will bring us back to the capital of Windhoek where you can spend the rest of the day relaxing.
21	Windhoek	You will be transported to the airport for your flight home.
